Unique Opportunity

With the Live Edge Program there is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity where you are purchasing a part of history. These trees were born during country's Civil War and many before the Revolutionary War.

Fast Facts

- Wood Species Available: most common are walnut, oak, cherry, maple along with other domestic and exotic hardwoods.
- Current Size Ranges (Live-Edge): Up to 18 feet in length, 20"-40" wide and 1½"-3" thick. Slabs may be cut to your specifications. Bark is always left on, but it can be removed upon request for additional costs.
- All slabs are reversible, there is no top or bottom. Both sides receive two coats of conversion varnish.
- Applications are unlimited. The most common use is for table tops. However they can be used for bars, desk tops, nightstands, end tables, sofa tables, mantels over fireplaces and more!

Character Makes the Difference

The selection process is the most important step in the acquisition of new slabs. Character is what makes this product special. A tree's unique character is formed over centuries of growth and exposure to the environment.

- All slabs are taken from trees 150 years old, at a minimum, and up to 400 years in some incidences.
- All slabs are hand-picked, and chosen for unique grain patterns and other characteristics, such as burls, twists, lead bullets, etc. Less than 5% of slabs inspected pass the stringent requirements set by our standards.
- After each selection, each slab is air-dried for 1-2 years, depending on the season of harvest and the weather conditions during the drying process. Next, they are kiln-dried for 8 weeks on average to achieve 6-8% moisture content. The total process can take approximately 2-4 years based on size and wood species.
- Live-edge slabs are cross sections of real trees; movement is to be expected along with cracking and bending. These natural characteristics will become more obvious during different seasons of the year, along with variations in humidity levels. These are not defects; this is a natural product with all the inherent characteristics that make each slab unique – a one-of-a-kind that can never be duplicated.
